Hello Makenzi,

As requested, ParkPro Tek inspected and assessed Sunchase Park. During our initial inspection we had hoped to find a route that would allow the playground to stay on site. After we assessed the playground and completed our inspection we came to the conclusion that the entire playground goes against the current ASTM and CPSC standards. Any alterations or changes to try to address the plethora of issues would only further the non-compliant nature of the playground. The cost to address the issues would far exceed what it would take to remove and replace the unit. This does not take into account the liability that would be associated with altering a playground such as this which does not seem to meet any of the ASTM standards set forth to protect children at play. It is in our professional judgment that this playground remain closed until it can be removed.
