RECITALS

- The District will no longer enforce deed restrictions against display of the attached described signs within the District.
- 2. The District shall respect any decisions by the Volente Hills at Park Forest Owners Association, Inc. and Hunter's Glenn Homeowners Association, Inc. to the extent such decisions conflict with this resolution.
